


This comparison graph (2018-2019 & 2019-2020) shows the significantly increased number of Entry Level 1 qualifications completed in the 2019-2020 academic year.

Another significant aspect of the Curriculum breadth in 2019-2020 is the focus on developing functional English and Maths with units such as Engaging in Early Reading Skills and Understanding what money is used for; and Preparation for Adulthood with units such as developing independent living skills (staying safe) and travel within the community.


This comparison graph (2018-2019 & 2019-2020) shows the significantly increased number of Entry Level 2 qualifications achieved during the academic year 2019-2020.

■ Number of Passes - 2019 -2020


Data Analysis – OCR EL3

This comparison graph (2018-2019 & 2019-2020) shows an overall increased number of Entry Level 3 qualifications completed during the academic year 2019-2020.

In some subject areas, more Entry Level 3 qualifications were achieved during the academic year 2018-2019, than the academic year 2019-2020. This relates to the different cohorts in each school year and to some learning restrictions posed by COVID-19.

It is important to note that in response to restrictions posed by COVID-19 the Duke of Edinburgh Awards in 2019-2020 were replaced by the Sectional Certificates - D of E Bronze Award. This made it possible for the pupils who had been working towards Duke of Edinburgh Record of Achievement Certificate to have their work recognised.

The plan for 2020-2021, is to expand the range of subjects offering accreditation routes for the Blue Learning Pathway. This will include vocational routes linked to CAREERS, productivity and, when possible, Employability.




Data Analysis - OCR L1




<u>Data Analysis – OCR L2</u>






<u>Data Analysis – AQA – UAS</u>

The plan for 2020-2021, is to expand to continue expanding opportunities for students to complete AQA Unit Award Scheme with links to CAREERS and productivity.




Data Analysis – AQA L2


