SEN Soft Play Sessions:

We have a number of SEN soft play sessions in different areas including Clay Cross, Chesterfield & Killamarsh - these are great opportunities to build confidence & friendships (both for the children/young people as well as parents/carers!) Nurturing & understanding environments for our children to play & be themselves! These sessions are just for us & not the general public so are often much quieter than mainstream soft play sessions too. Siblings welcome too!





Movement To Music:

Lighthearted & fun monthly dance sessions led by the fantastic Sunflower Dance. A low demand group to encourage exercise & socialisation in an engaging & dynamic way. These sessions are brilliant opportunities to have fun with your child/young person as well as meet others! Siblings welcome too!



Level-Up:

Monthly social sessions to meet others, make some new friends as well as build confidence & self-esteem. Wonderful opportunities to play a variety of board games as well as enjoy lovely drinks & food from the Board & Bean Cafe in a calm & relaxing environment. Fun for all the family!







Creative Connections:

Monthly Creative Arts sessions to help encourage new interests & hobbies, meet others & build friendships, as well as encouraging confidence building & self expression. This low demand group is aimed to support individuals to try new things & explore art, music, movement & drama activities. Come join to meet others & have fun! (for ages 11-25 years)



On Friday mornings we have our social drop-in sessions where parents/carers can come to discuss any support & advice they may need whilst enjoying a good cup of tea! Our children's worker is also here to help entertain any children/young people who come too. This can be a great social opportunity for all the family! We have a secure play area to keep everyone safe as well as lots of toys & activities for all ages (0-25 years)









Parent/Carer Support Groups:

We have a number of different parent/carer support groups in numerous locations throughout each month. These sessions are wonderful opportunities to meet others, share advice & support as well as build understanding friendship groups. Lots of opportunities for peer support as well as help from the NeuroHub Team!



1:1 APPOINTMENTS JULY 2025

As well as our NeuroHub parent/carer support groups, family sessions & activities for children/young people - we also have 1:1 appointments available with our Neurodivergence Support Advisor. These sessions are aimed to give allocated time to discuss support for your child in our private 'Home from Home' Hub at the Fairplay Centre. During these sessions there is the opportunity to get tailored advice & guidance for your family, signposted to any other relevant services, time to make personalised resources & any other support you feel you may need, including linking with schools & other services involved.

If you do not feel that you need an appointment but still have questions & would like to talk to a professional then please feel free to talk to our staff at any of our other sessions! All of our staff are fellow SEND parents & will always offer knowledgeable, empathetic and understanding support! 
