

Applying for University

Eligibility Criteria: You are study an undergraduate or postgraduate course, live in the UK outside term time, have qualified for your Student Finance loans and have evidence to back your claim which affects your study e.g assessment of needs

DSA is granted in addition to any other student finance you may receive. Money received from an accepted DSA claim is classified as a grant and does not need to be repaid by the student. It may be beneficial to you to inform your first choice university of any accepted DSA claims to enable the university to start to communicate to faculties for support to be allocated quickly and efficiently for the start of your course.

Once you have received your documentation from DSA you can start to arrange your support. Arranging support early means you will be in front of the influx of students who will be sorting theirs out during their first term - Which is a much slower process.
