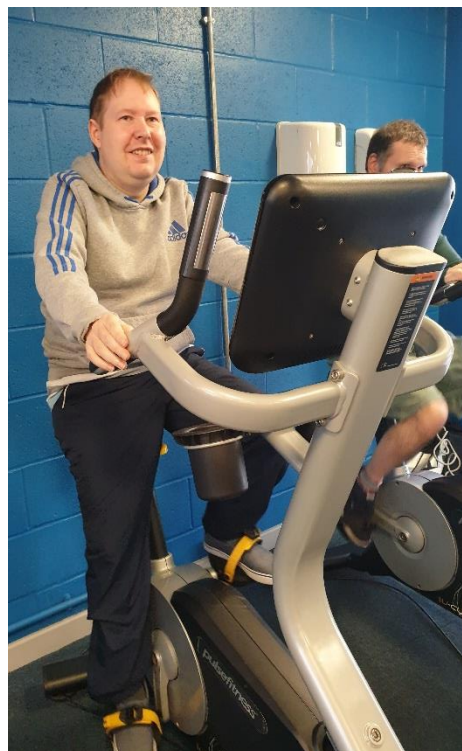


The lads on a Thursday still really enjoy going to the Canal to help the community pick up litter, here's a photo of the lads going recently.
