How to find Kingsthorpe Baptist Church:

By bus from Northampton centre: 19 Violet/19A Violet from Broad Street and Regent Street every 15 min.

By road: use the postcode NN2 7BD in your Sat Nav – this is the postcode for Waitrose. Head north up the A508 Harborough Road, out of Northampton. You'll pass the intersection with the Cock Inn on the left, keep going and you will pass an ASDA, then turn left into the car park of Waitrose. You can park in the Waitrose car park, and if you're going to be longer than 2 hours let hub staff know.

Don't go to the High Street entrance of the church, as our entrance is located behind Waitrose at the back of the car park – as you look at Waitrose, walk round it to the right (still in the car park) and you will see a red brick building on the right – that's where we are!
